



### Bar Visiting Requirements

The following new operating requirements need to be followed by all visitors to the Club from July 12<sup>th</sup> 2020 in order to comply with Government guidelines and mitigate the risk of Covid-19:

- Please wash your hands before you commence your journey to the Club
- On arrival please enter via the front entrance only. You should not enter via the patio doors and the door to the Charles Jackson room shall remain locked. To leave the building please use the patio doors only. If you wish to visit the toilets you must leave the building via the patio doors and enter the building through the front door. Do not reverse the general direction flow and visit the toilets directly from the main room. Please follow any arrows on display.
- On arrival you will be asked for your name by the bar person who will record it on the visitor member list. All non-members need their details entered by the bar person into the visitor book. All visitors to the Club need to be recorded to comply with the Govt Track and Trace requirements which will be kept for at least 14 days.
- Only one person is allowed to use the toilets at a time. Please knock on the door before entering and if somebody is in there please wait away from the doorway for them to leave. When you finish in the toilet please wash your hands.
- Please only sit on the chairs provided, please do not move a chair to another part of the room. Please do not stand in the main room, please use the seats provided. If outside, please use the seats provided or sit on the grass; single seats can be moved for this process but please return them afterwards. In all cases please keep 2M apart.
- Smokers need to smoke towards the side of the scoreboard furthest away from the Clubhouse. Although legally it is permissible to smoke in the open area as many of our members are likely to use the patio area, we request that smokers do not smoke here.
- When paying for your drinks, it would be preferable if you could use your debit card. Cash payments are still permissible, but preference is for card payments. Please order your drink at the bar (there is a 2m distance barrier) and then collect your drinks from a drinks table nearby.
- Please do not shout or sing in the Club or outside as this can cause a spread of vapour. No spitting. Please note that the windows will be kept open within the Club to help the flow of air.
- Only the bar person will use the remote for the TV. Please ask them if you would like the TV on / channel change etc.
- Areas and equipment currently unavailable are the Charles Jackson room, the Kitchen, darts and the pool table. The table football has been removed.
- Please note there will be sanitiser available at the Club, please use it periodically and any tissues used should be properly disposed in a bin following their use.
